ommunity groups, including the Indian Trail Improvement District Recreation Community, Acreage Horse Owners Association and Acreage Athletic League, identified a need for various recreational opportunities in their community of the Acreage in western Palm Beach County. Urban Design Kilday Studios worked with these committees, as well as the Indian Trail Improvement District and Palm Beach County, to analyze available properties and prepare conceptual site plans for recreational fascilites. These include a park dedicated for equestrian activities, one dedicated specifically for small children, several parks for court sports, including basketball, tennis and racquetball, and several Little League baseball parks.

All of the proposed designs were reviewed and refined based on committee and public input. UDKS prepared final site layouts plans and processed the necessary zoning applications, providing representation as the projects proceeded through the Palm Beach County governmental approval process. UDKS also prepared construction plans and landscape plans, as well as provided limited construction administration during the development of the parks. The last park was completed in 2000. These parks have become a valuable amenity to the Acreage Community.
