

CENTRAL BOULEVARD

PALM BEACH GARDENS, FLORIDA

Central Boulevard is located in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida and is the east boundary of the Old Palm Golf Community. The project limits are between PGA Boulevard and I-95. The streetscape design services provided by Urban Design Kilday Studios included Planting, Irrigation, and Hardscape for this important corridor in the City. The design integrated existing planting within the right-of-way, with new proposed planting designs that unified the street. The end result was a lushly landscaped roadway with canopy trees, specimen palms, and a variety of colorful shrubs and ground covers. UDKS worked closely with the project Civil Engineer for safe sight line issues, and with the City of Palm Beach Gardens Police Department for CPTED issues.

Irrigation for this large streetscape area is supplied from within Old Palm. The irrigation system covers the entire road shoulder on the west and north, and the medians between PGA Boulevard and I-95. The irrigation design integrated watering restriction timelines, pedestrian circulation along the parkway, and best design practices for operation and water use.

The Central Boulevard Planting, Hardscape, and Irrigation plans were reviewed and approved by Palm Beach County, and The City of Palm Beach Gardens. UDKS saw the project from concept to final certifications with Palm Beach County Engineering and Landscape Divisions. The final design reflects the City of Palm Beach Gardens' commitment to landscape beautification, and has become a great example of streetscape in a Signature City.
