

CRESTWOOD BOULEVARD

ROYAL PALM BEACH, FL

Urban Design Kilday Studios worked with the Village of Royal Palm Beach to landscape the Crestwood Boulevard right-of-way during the boulevard's expansion from a two-lane road to a four-lane road with medians. The length of Crestwood Boulevard UDKS designed occurs between Okeechobee Boulevard and Southern Boulevard and is approximately 1.75 miles in length. The boulevard winds through a variety of residential neighborhoods, giving the drive a natural setting running through areas of tracts of preservation with lakes adjacent to the road and islands in the lakes. In actuality, the feel of the road is a reflection of the community it services.

UDKS provided landscape and irrigation design services as well as County Streetscape, SFWMD water use permitting and construction observation services. The landscape design of the median is simple, relying on stately royal palms and live oak trees to line the boulevard's medians with controlled amounts of shrubs and groundcovers under plantings.
