

VICTORIA GARDENS AVENUE

PALM BEACH GARDENS, FLORIDA

Victoria Gardens Avenue is located in the City of Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, at the southeast intersection of PGA Boulevard and Alternate A1A. This project combined public roadway beautification for the “PGA Flyover Bridge” with beautification requirements for the Legacy Place Mixed Use Project. A coordinated effort was led by Urban Design Kilday Studios to navigate through the various agencies for approval. By integrating the landscape design of the “PGA Flyover Bridge” with that of Legacy Place, Victoria Gardens Avenue has become an important connection for vehicles, pedestrian and bicyclists at this central location.

UDKS applied for and secured grant funding through Keep Palm Beach County Beautiful Inc. for the Victoria Gardens Avenue project. The project received 50% matching funds from the grant. A detailed application and subsequent budget administration was required for securing the funds. The Landscape plans were reviewed and approved by The City of Palm Beach Gardens, Florida Department of Transportation and Seacoast Utility Authority. UDKS worked closely with the City of Palm Beach Gardens Police Department regarding CPTED issues. The final design reflects wide meandering sidewalks, with predominantly native planting, and street and pedestrian lighting. The design wraps around the lake creating an amenity with both street trees and aquatic planting.
