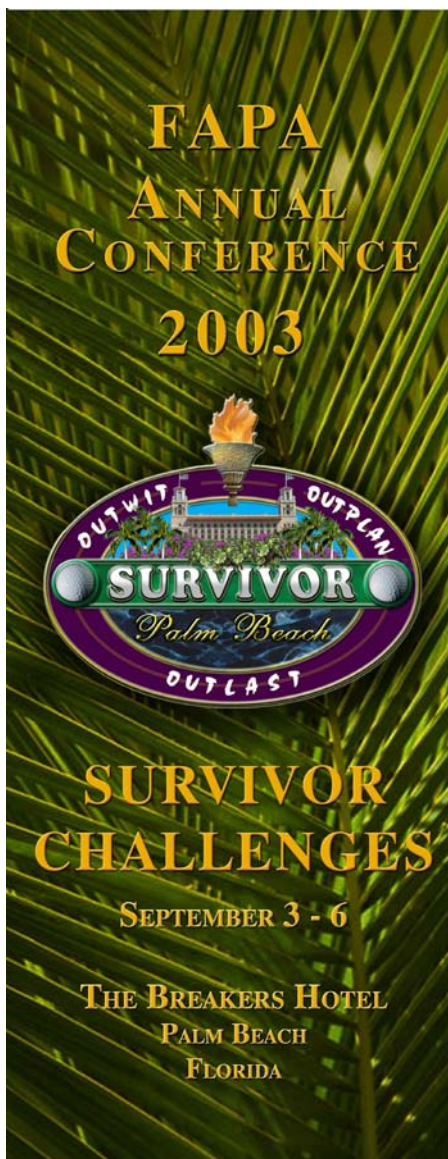


The Florida Chapter of American Planning Association sponsors an annual convention devoted to the exploration and discussion of issues critical to the State's growth management programs.
