

THE TOWN EXECUTIVE CENTER

BOCA RATON, FLORIDA

The exterior design of the Town Executive Center reflects the architectural character of the 60,000 square foot building, offering bold, clean, simple lines, while creating a series of intimate pedestrian spaces on the 2.5 acre site. Urban Design Kilday Studios utilized this approach in their design of the outdoor spaces. The outdoor plaza incorporates not only tile walkways and private seating areas, but a grass patio surrounded by shade trees that mirrors the building's floor plan. A pedestrian arcade is lined with shade trees growing through grates. Large ficus trees were preserved and transplanted from on site to the project's most visible corner, thus achieving the client's goal of establishing an immediate look of maturity for the development.

Both the American Society of Landscape Architects (Florida Chapter) and the Florida Nurserymen and Grower's Association have honored the project with awards. The ASLA jury cited the project's overall design as "a bold, simple plan reinforcing the geometry of the building."
