

CURRIE CORRIDOR REDEVELOPMENT PLAN

NORTHWOOD/PLEASANT CITY, FLORIDA

Currie Corridor Mixed Use District is an area within the Northwood/Pleasant City CRA boundary of West Palm Beach, Florida that experienced an exciting renaissance and renewed interest by the development community. To ensure guidelines were in place to help shape all development, Urban Design Kilday Studios prepared a detailed Streetscape Plan which will serve both in regulating and also creating a sense of continuity in the future.

This framework plan set priorities and established thresholds for the Currie Corridor area that focused on vehicular and pedestrian circulation, streetscape improvements, specialty lighting, identity markers and community thematics. The plan

also aided renovation and facade improvements to existing structures while providing strategies for incorporating new mixed use and public space opportunities.

UDKS was assembled with a professional team of engineers to provide urban planning and landscape architecture. Illustrative graphics produced by the design team convey the rebirth and vision of the Currie Corridor community.
