Urban Design Kilday Studios assisted the United States Postal Service (USPS) and their architects in obtaining development approvals for a new Postal Facility in unincorporated Palm Beach County. Initially, feasibility research was performed to determine if the project complied with the County's property development regulations. Although not required to do so, the USPS voluntarily agreed to conform. That included developing a rural design for the building and incorporating equestrian facilities to fit into the Acreage community. UDKS prepared and processed the rezoning application, preparing the accompanying site plan and providing representation of the project within the community and at the public hearings.

Following the rezoning approval, UDKS prepared construction landscape plan for the project, incorporating existing vegetation where possible. A native plant palette was established.
