

PGA BOULEVARD

PALM BEACH GARDENS, FLORIDA

Urban Design Kilday Studios has worked on the PGA Boulevard Corridor since the early 1990s. The first design project occurred between Military Trail and Florida's Turnpike and involved landscape and irrigation designs for the median and 55' wide Parkway Buffers along the northern and southern perimeters of the road. The Parkway Buffers provide residences a safe, aesthetic pathway system while buffering the roadway from adjacent development, breaking away from strip commercial development buffering residential from arterials.

UDKS recently completed work on the median landscape and irrigation designs for the western portion of PGA Boulevard from Florida's Turnpike to the western limits of PGA National and Mirasol. The landscape theme of native tree canopies with natural shrub and groundcover massing has remained consistent with the earlier patterns of the eastern portion of the Boulevard.
