

# QUADRILLE (EL CAMPEON) BOULEVARD

WEST PALM BEACH, FLORIDA

Urban Design Kilday Studios prepared conceptual design drawings and final construction plans and specifications for a +1.0 mile street construction project from Okeechobee Boulevard to Dixie Highway, which included the first roundabout traffic-calming device in downtown West Palm Beach.

UDKS performed site analysis, data gathering, consensus building and coordination with City Staff, the Downtown Property Owners' Association, the Downtown Development Authority and the City of West Palm Beach Community Redevelopment Agency. Public workshops and presentations were held and a final design program established.

UDKS also performed construction administration services for the City, as well as completed a final checklist for the project. Services included planting design; selecting site furnishings; design of pedestrian, vehicular and bicycle access; and lighting and irrigation design.

Landscape design elements incorporated xeriscape principals, low maintenance, plant material hardiness and aesthetic value. The project was completed in June 1995.
