

ST. MARY'S CAMPUS MASTER PLAN

WEST PALM BEACH, FLORIDA

In 1992, Urban Design Kilday Studios prepared and processed a zoning petition on behalf of St. Mary's Hospital. Approval was granted for an overall Campus Master Plan reflecting future development. Portions of the approval have been constructed including several medical office buildings and an ambulatory surgical center. In 1999, UDKS processed a major amendment to this Campus Master Plan to include a new children's hospital wing, Quantum Children's Village and a new service center. This involved preparing applications for submittal to the City of West Palm Beach and working with the client's architectural and engineering consultants.

UDKS provided representation of the project at both the staff level and at public hearings. In addition, meetings with neighborhood representatives were held to address their concerns and obtain support for the project. UDKS prepared final landscape and irrigation design construction documents for Quantum Children's Village, which was constructed in 2001.
