#### PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE:

Mr. McCormick attended the University of Florida from 2005 – 2009 where he studied to earn his BS in Landscape Architecture. While at the University, he had an opportunity to study design and urban environments in cities throughout the United States and locations worldwide in countries such as Singapore and Indonesia. He also participated in two professional internships with Urban Design Kilday Studios from 2007-2008 where he acquired hands on design experience in landscape design and urban planning applications.
