PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE:

In 1979 Mr. Bridge began his professional career in Fort Lauderdale, Florida at Warren E. McCormick and Associates. His work experience ranged from single family residential designs to large scale residential landscape designs such as Brickell Key in Miami, to assistance with the development of the Martin Downs DRI.

In 1984 Mr. Bridge came to Palm Beach County to work for Urban Design Kilday Studios. His work experience ranged from project landscape architect to project manager and most recently Director of Landscape Architecture. Since joining the firm he has worked on large scale residential golf course communities like BallenIsles Country Club in Palm Beach Gardens. His experience also includes involvement in the landscape design for many large scale public sector projects like Palm Beach International Airport, South County Waste Water Treatment Plant, Seaboard Railway Station, Benjamin Upper School, Seacoast Utility Authority, and South County Courthouse. Other more recent public sector work includes the design and observation of construction for the new ER Expansion at Palm Beach Medical, which included the successful relocation of 14 large live oak trees within a freshly landscaped ER Facility.

Private sector commercial projects include work on Shoppes on the Green at PGA National, Admiral's Crossing in Jupiter, Target Super Center in Palm Beach County, the Walgreen's Distribution Center in the Palm Beach Park of Commerce, and City Centre, an upscale commercial/office complex on Alternate A1A in Palm Beach Gardens. Private sector residential designs include Courtney Village, a 17 acre residential community, La Posada, a 22 acre continuing care residential community, Prosperity Oaks, a 27 acre elderly residential development and Paloma, a 165 acre single and multi-family community in Palm Beach Gardens.
