PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE:

After positions in the business field with Flagler Federal Savings & Loan and Globe Communications, Ms. Brinkman accepted a position with Winston Lee & Associates, Inc. in 1986, where she learned various aspects of the planning profession. In 1994, she began employment with Urban Design Kilday Studios as a zoning technician where she gained further knowledge of the planning and zoning profession with work concentrating mostly in unincorporated Palm Beach County. From 1996 to 2003, she was again employed by Winston Lee & Associates as a project manager, where she did extensive work in the planning field in Palm Beach County and various municipalities. Ms. Brinkman also worked on eminent domain cases throughout South Florida for both condemning authorities and property owners, gaining extensive well-rounded planning experience. From 2003 to 2006, she operated her own company, Joni Brinkman & Associates.

In February of 2006, Ms. Brinkman accepted a project manager position with Urban Design Kilday Studios which resulted shortly thereafter in a promotion to the position of planning director for the firm, overseeing a staff of four planners. In addition to the management duties associated with the position, she has continued to provide services in condemnation cases, land use changes, rezonings, site plan approvals, etc., in unincorporated Palm Beach County, Broward County and various municipalities therein. Project manager services have been provided on various local projects, including the Palm Beach Atlantic University's library, pool facilities, dormitories and athletic fields and the Solid Waste Authority's Western Landfill. Industrial projects include the Premier Airport Center and the Premier Park of Commerce, both located in the City of West Palm Beach. Commercial projects include the redevelopment of the Garden Shoppes of Boca Shopping Center in the Boca Raton area of Palm Beach County and institutional projects include the new Glades Replacement Hospital as well as the E.J. Healey Replacement Facility in Riviera Beach for the Healthcare District of Palm Beach County. The Expedited Permitting Process, thru the Governor's Office of Tourism, Trade & Economic Development was utilized for the land use and zoning approvals for the Glades Replacement Hospital, resulting in a greatly reduced approval time frame.
